Introduction

To ensure consistency in educational provision at Future Leaders International Private School - Branch 2, we adhere to a structured academic calendar in compliance with ADEK's requirements. Public holidays will be observed to promote social cohesion and reflect the UAE's national identity.

Purpose

- Ensure the school calendar aligns with ADEK's requirements.
- Keep the parents updated and informed about all holidays & events.

Definitions

- Calendar: A structured schedule that includes school days, holidays, term start and end dates, and other ADEK-mandated dates.
- Public Holiday: Official non-working days for religious, national, or other officially declared events.
- School Break: Periods such as summer, spring, and winter breaks when no compulsory activities take place.

Policy

Calendar Submission

- Future Leaders International Private School Branch - 2 is committed to submit the proposed academic calendar through the ADEK Calendar System for approval.
- The school may either follow ADEK's suggested calendar or create its own while adhering to ADEK's mandatory parameters (e.g., school start and end dates, school breaks, and minimum teaching days).
- Examination dates will be included in the calendar.
- The school will submit the calendar within the deadlines set by ADEK.
- Once approved, the school will share the calendar with staff, students, and parents.

Public Holidays

- The school will observe public holidays listed in the ADEK Calendar System.
- Public holidays are subject to change based on official government announcements.
- If a public holiday conflicts with international or external examinations, the school may conduct classes but must obtain prior approval from ADEK.
