Purpose

This policy outlines the procedures and operational guidelines governing coeducation and gender arrangements at Future Leaders International School - Branch 2.

The policy ensures compliance with ADEK's School Coeducation Policy and aims to:

- Respect cultural values and privacy expectations.
- Ensure safe and appropriate interaction between students.
- Clarify gender requirements for staff and school operations.
- Provide clear guidance for students, staff, parents, and visitors.

Scope

This policy applies to all stakeholders

School Gender Status

FLIS Branch 2 operates under a coeducation structure in all grade levels in accordance with ADEK regulations and cultural considerations.

Students from PreKG to Grade 12 study in mixed-gender classrooms.

This gender structure:

- Is declared to ADEK through the School Gender Status Declaration Form
- Is reflected in the school's operational procedures
- Is communicated to staff and parents after ADEK confirmation.

Any modification to the gender structure requires prior written approval from ADEK.

Classroom Organization

In all classes

- Students learn in coeducational classrooms.
- Boys and girls participate together in academic activities.
- Teachers encourage respectful interaction and collaboration.

Gender Requirements for Staff

1. Kindergarten Staff

In accordance with ADEK regulations:

All KG teachers and teaching assistants must be females.

2. Physical Education Teachers

The school follows ADEK gender guidelines for Physical Education.

- Pre-KG – Grade 4: students are together taught by a female teacher
- Grade 5 and Above: PE instruction must be supervised by teachers of the same gender as the student section where required.

School Facilities and Privacy

1. Prayer Facilities

- The school provides separate male and female prayer rooms with ablution facilities, which may be used by both students and staff.

The school ensures that prayer facilities are supervised and maintained in a manner that respects religious practices, cultural expectations, and student privacy

2. School Clinic

The school clinic operates according to ADEK regulations.

- A female nurse is always available on campus.

3. Toilets

The school provides separate toilet facilities for male and female students. Facilities are clearly labeled and supervised to ensure privacy and safety.

4. School Transportation

The school provides transportation services that comply with ADEK safety, supervision, and cultural requirements.

- All school buses are supervised by female bus assistants.

5. Cleaning Staff

Cleaning staff allocations follow the gender restrictions as per the ADEK policy.

Where cleaning occurs during school hours in the canteen or playgrounds areas, students are not usually present.

Policy Awareness and Training

Awareness sessions are regularly organized to ensure all members of the school community (students, staff, and parents) are aware of this policy.
