Parental Role and Responsibilities in Cultural Consideration

This section outlines the responsibilities of parents in maintaining a culturally considerate environment, ensuring that students receive an education that aligns with the values and regulations of the UAE.

1. Induction and Ongoing Awareness

- Parents participate in cultural consideration awareness induction sessions upon their child's enrollment at the school.
- Annual refresher training is provided to ensure parents remain informed about UAE cultural norms and expectations.

2. Respect for UAE Cultural Norms and Community Conduct

- Parents uphold and respect the cultural and social values, norms, and traditions of the UAE.
- Parents ensure that their interactions and communications within the school community reflect cultural sensitivity and do not promote stereotypes or preconceptions about the UAE.
- Parents refrain from engaging in or endorsing behaviors, practices, or displays that are culturally inappropriate, including discussions or materials related to alternative gender identity and sexual orientation, drug and alcohol use, violence, and indoctrination.
- Parents do not use or promote symbols, colors, or imagery associated with political, social, or extremist religious groups that are inconsistent with UAE cultural considerations.
- o Parents maintain culturally appropriate attire when attending school-related events.
- Parents support the school's efforts to ensure that all school-organized events and celebrations align with UAE cultural values.

3. Parental Oversight of Online Content

 Parents actively monitor their child's internet usage at home to minimize exposure to inappropriate content.
